

CAMP RULES:



Because of my desire for growth and maturity in Christ through the opportunity of Super Summer, I am in agreement and will submit to the following guidelines. I fully understand that the violation of these rules will result in my immediate return home at my own expense.

CELL PHONES:

- The decision of cell phone usage at camp is in the hands of the group leader of each church.
- Throughout the week, some elements may allow students and adults to join in via social media (i.e., Twitter, Instagram, Facebook, etc.) However, these opportunities are optional and will not limit the camp experience for those who do not participate.
- Unless instructed by staff, students with cell phones are not allowed to have them out or in use during
 programming elements: morning celebration, Bible study, worship, night life, recreation and breakout
 times. Ringers should be turned to silent or vibrate.

ACTIVITIES:

- Participate in all activities and be on time.
- Drink plenty of water and eat three meals a day.
- Wear closed-toe and closed-heel shoes to recreation and breakouts.
- Wear your name tag at all times.

Housing:

- Be in your room by 10:30 PM with lights out no later than 11:00 PM.
- No guys in girls' rooms or hallways and no girls in guys' rooms or hallways.
- No public displays of affection. This is a week to work on your relationship with God.
- · No practical jokes.
- No gum, food, or drinks allowed in the worship center.
- No video and flash photography are allowed in the worship center before or during the worship service.
- Sleeveless tops are allowed but no tank tops during worship.
- Lake Yale Baptist Conference Center facilities are to be treated with respect. **Any damage will be charged** to all students booked in that room or cabin.

DURING CAMP:

- Abide by Super Summer dress code.
- Participants must not use personal vehicles for any reason.
- Students are not allowed off campus. Once the student is registered, they may not leave campus until checkout, unless an adult signs them out in the Super Summer Office.
- Fireworks, firearms, knives, or any other kind of weapon, alcohol, drugs, or any form of tobacco are NOT allowed. These it ems can be destructive to you and those around you. Also, DO NOT BRING skateboards, water guns, airsoft guns, video games, laser pointers, DVD players, tablets of any kind, laptops, or televisions. Also, paint is not allowed in the hotel rooms or cabins.
- Ordering food to be delivered on campus is forbidden. In fairness to everyone, we will eat in the campus cafeterias. Snacks and Late Nite Bites are available in the Snack Shack.
